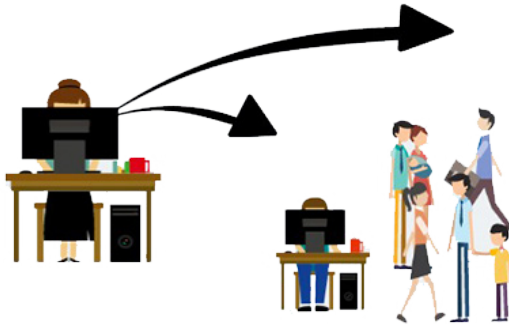


Where do my home listings go?

Agents interested in your home will see it in search results. Buyers and Agents will also receive notice through saved and auto searches.



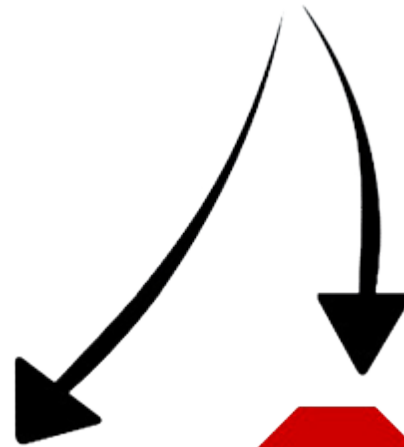
Do you want your listing sent to consumer websites? Upload to internet: Y/N decides the next stop for your home.



Listing Syndication
Your home will be sent to consumer websites like Zillow, Trulia and Homes.com many different ways including: ListHub, direct broker or franchise feeds, and other third party feeds.



Upload to Internet: YES
Your home listing is sent to IDX websites, realtor.com and TalktoPenny.com



Upload to Internet: NO
